The Truckee Fire Protection District is seeking candidates for the position of Fire Prevention Forester.

Key Duties and Responsibilities:

Under general supervision of the Fire Marshal, to perform a full range of technical duties involved in vegetation management and forestry inspections, provide assistance to the general public, and to provide technical support to Fire District staff.

Job Requirements:

The applicant must be a Registered Professional Forester with a valid license with a minimum of 10 years of experience practicing forestry in California. He/she must have knowledge of the following programs:

- Vegetation Management Program (VMP)
- California Forest Improvement Program (CFIP)
- SRA Fire Prevention Fee Grant
- Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund (GGRF)
- Cooperative Fire Grants

A working knowledge of the California Forest Practice Rules, Public Resource Code, the Timber Harvest Plan Process and the applicability of the THP Exemption process is required. Also, knowledge of fire behavior as it is taught in NWCG 290, 390 and 490 classes will enable the applicant to support the design and implementation of fuel reduction projects for the Truckee Fire Protection District.

Valid driver's license and proof of insurability are required.

Interested candidates must submit a District employment application and attach a current resume. All application materials will be evaluated and only the most highly qualified candidates will be invited to continue in the selection process.
